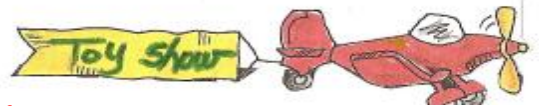

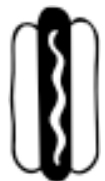
Guys' & Gals' Redneck Toy Show
